Education Team



The team of education specialists are certified educators with concentrations and/or additional degree(s) in special education. Each specialist has a geographic area of responsibility to ensure intimate knowledge about the educational landscape of the area(s). They provide support to families to ease education transitions and to aide in educational continuity. Possible topics in which they can assist are: special education,

English as a Second Language, 504 accommodations, gifted education, high school transitions, post secondary support, U.S. related coursework, homeschool support, and academic support.

Resource Management Team

The resource management team ensures the timely processing of invoices and provides support on financial related matters such as reimbursements, refunds, allowable and non-allowable expenses.
